

FUMC Centennial Moments for October: ABC's

First Church Acolytes, Bible Bearers, and Crucifers (ABC's) are a vital part of our traditional worship services and have been a long-standing part of our history. We believe they are such an important part of our service that our youngest members learn how to participate in this ministry each week during "Little Church". What exactly do each of these positions involve? The Acolyte carries the light into worship to signify Jesus coming into the presence of the worshipping community and, at the end of service, the Acolyte carries the light out to symbolize Jesus going



out into the world. The **Bible Bearer brings God's Word** to the altar as we come together to study the scriptures. The **Crucifer brings the cross** to represent the Lord's presence at the altar. The ABC ministry is one of the earliest ways for our children and youth to serve in the life of the church.



A **Healing Service** will be held **today**, **Sunday**, **October 13th** at all three worship services—a time for individuals to bring forward a prayer request of healing to be prayed over and anointed with oil by one of our ministers.
