United Methodist Women is a community of women whose PURPOSE is to know God and to experience freedom as whole persons through Jesus Christ, to develop a creative, supportive fellowship, and to expand concepts of missions through participation in the global ministries of the church. The organization is 150 years old this year. At First Church, the first circle was formed in 1933. Currently, we have five circles that meet monthly and are very active in all church activities.

UMW has held several fundraisers throughout the year: Rada cutlery, pecans, hibiscus plants, poinsettias, calendars, lights for the oak tree, spaghetti dinner, and a huge "yard" sale. The proceeds go to local missions: Helping Hands, Coastal Rescue Mission, Family Justice Center, New Directions, Hope House, Myrtle Beach primary, elementary, middle and intermediate schools for needy students, and four UMW sponsored South Carolina missions. The women of UMW have also helped flood victims, the College Ministry, the Community Kitchen, Help 4 Kids as volunteers, held a sock drive, beginning an underwear campaign for shelters, adopted a needy family at Christmas, stuffed back packs with school supplies, Reading Buddies volunteers at the schools—and more!

All women are invited to join us. If you unable to attend a monthly circle meeting, you can become a "Member at Large" and attend the general meetings held four times a year. These usually include an informative program and lunch. It is also time to see members you might not normally cross paths with and find out what everyone is doing. The next general meeting is November 5th at 11:00AM in the church parlor.

Join us as we put God's love in action.
