Members have participated in many fundraising activities to support missions that help women and children in need. In the past, funds have been raised in different ways including bake sales, a talent show, dinners, choral groups, and Christmas lights for the large oak tree on the front lawn. Also, the Myrtle Beach Cookin' Too cookbook is still available for purchase. One of our largest events is the **annual yard sale** that was held this past August. As a result of this function, UMW **donated \$3,300** to The Family Justice Center. The Center is able to house women and their children in an emergency shelter, help with case management, counsel and court advocacy. Also, additional funds were donated to four other missions.
