FUMC Centennial Moments for November: Columbarium

In 2010, Ann and Charles Crutchfield, members of First Church, raised the idea of adding a Columbarium to our church property. A committee was formed and visits were made to several churches in the area to see what others had done. Plans were made and drawings were completed; approvals were given and work started in the Fall of 2015. The plan was to build one section at a time with enclosed walls and have additional sections to be added later as niches were sold. A Memorial Wall was included so plaques could be set in memory of a loved one who is buried elsewhere. It is situated in a peaceful area with benches to provide seating while visiting. Its location is on the front lawn beside the Chapel. The Columbarium was dedicated November 1, 2015. The cremated remains of the Crutchfields reside in Columbarium niches.
