

### FUMC Centennial Moments for November: Dutch Cradle Cross/Baby Shawls

The **Dutch Cradle Cross**, a Dutch tradition, is a wooden cross inscribed with the verse, Matthew 19:14. One is placed on the Altar the week of the child's birth in honor of the child. It is to be placed over the head of the child's bed and symbolizes Christian faith.

**Baby Shawl** is a small prayer shawl knit or crocheted by our "Knit One Ministry" for a new baby to wrapped in God's love or placed on or near the baby's bed. The prayer shawls are prayed over as they are made. This same group also makes larger shawls and lap covers that are given to people who are ill or to someone who is dealing with stressful situations and need to feel the help of God.

**Nursery Home Visitors**—This mission began many years ago by Joyce Quattlebaum; Lydia Hussey Banks was also active in this mission. When the church is notified that a new family addition is expected, the Nursery Home Visitor, Cindy Johnson, makes a call to the family and visits them providing information about our church, the church nursery, Baptism, Little Church, Sunday School and CDM. Also in the packet taken to the family is a Dutch Cradle Cross, a Baby Shawl, a New Testament, and a tag to attach to a diaper bag reminding them that the church and God love them. The church's programs and missions follow a child from birth through college by volunteers and staff.
