

FUMC Centennial Moments for October: All Saints'/Heritage Sunday

All Saints' Day is recognized on the first Sunday in November, a day we remember and celebrate all Christian people who have passed on to life eternal. At First Church, we display the All Saints' Banner containing ribbon streamers on which bells are placed by individuals as a memorial remembering their loved ones. During worship, candles are lighted and a bell chimes as each name is read aloud for those who have passed during the year.





The first Sunday in November is also recognized as Heritage Sunday. On November 5, 1939, First Church held its first worship service in a brand new brick building, attended by the people in the Myrtle Beach area. Rev. Pierce E. Cook was the first full-time minister. A proud and thankful congregation heard his first sermon entitled,

"The House of God". Membership on roll was 200. This same building serves today as our Sanctuary.

First UMC celebrated its 100th birthday on September 29, 2019 as the "first church" in Myrtle Beach with a large crowd and special guests. Rev. Dr. George K. Howle's sermon title was, "Upon Christ, We Build This Church", and beautiful music was offered by the choir, orchestra, and hand bell choir. With beautiful weather, Magnolia's provided and served a delicious meal on the front lawn under tents and also in the Parlor. What a tremendous day of celebration!
