FUMC Centennial Moments for December: Hanging of the Greens

This is the time of the year we prepare our Church, our hearts, and our minds, for the **Season of Advent**. This preparation is started several days before the start of Advent. The Hanging of Greenery is traditionally associated with everlasting life. The Christmas trees are covered with Chrismons, ornaments made by the people of the



church. An Advent Wreath is made and Christmas banners may be hung. Lots of greenery, bows and ribbons, are used to decorate. Each window ledges display greenery, as do the railing and on the wings of the Sanctuary. During the week of Christmas, beautiful poinsettias are placed around the Altar. Wreaths adorn the front doors of the

Church, and the Live Oak tree on the front lawn is covered in strands of lights. All of the decorating, preparing for the celebration of Jesus's birth, takes many volunteers who give of their time, talents, and their love for the Church and the Advent Season.


