
#### FUMC Centennial Moments for December: Shepherd's Child

**LONGEST NIGHT WORSHIP, Thursday, December 19th**, at **5:00PM in the Chapel.** For many people, the approaching Christmas holiday does not bring with it the joy and happiness that is advertised on television or in greeting cards. They may be facing a holiday after the death of a loved one or after a divorce. Perhaps they have been unable to have a child or have suffered through an

emotional trauma; or perhaps they feel pressured and overwhelmed by holiday preparations. 
