

FUMC Centennial Moments for August: CDM—FUMC North Campus

The Child Development Ministry is located on the North Campus of First Church, 905 65th Ave North, and is housed in one of the two buildings on campus. The other building, the Thomas N. Brittain Center, is used primarily for other church functions and activities, but also hosts special CDM programs and activities.

The main CDM building has fourteen classrooms, administrative offices, a parenting center and a chapel. Outside are basketball and volleyball courts. There are also soccer fields that are leased to the YMCA. A special feature at the front entrance of the building is a musical garden in memory of Eddie White, a dedicated supporter of the CDM.

Grants from Burroughs and Chapin Corporation have made it possible to have a playground behind the building and fencing around the entire campus. CDM provides an attractive and safe environment for the children and staff.

A non-profit Christian program of the **Medical University of South Carolina Children's Hospital**. The goal of Happy Wheels is to brighten the days of **hospitalized children ranging from infants to age 17**.

The Happy Wheels gift cart visits approximately **80 children each week**. During a child's hospital stay, he or she **chooses a book**, **puzzle**, **or hand-held toy from the cart**. The value of each gift usually ranges from \$8-\$16. Donation receptacles are located in the church office.
