FUMC Centennial Moments for August: Child Development Center-History

First United Methodist Church of Myrtle Beach has had a child care ministry since 1978 when it offered the first Mother's Morning Out program in Myrtle Beach. Over the next four years, 3 and 4-year old preschool classes were added. These classes were held in the Wesley Building.

In 1982, a focus on day care began to grow out of FUMC staff need. Rev. Debra Quilling, Associate Minister, had her first child; when she returned to work, she brought her infant son with her to the office. This brought the need to the attention of Rev. Tom Brittain, Senior Minister. Under his and Rev. Quilling's leadership, a day care center opened for children 1 to 2-1/2 years old along with 3 and 4-year old preschool classes in the Wesley Building. In 1987, a board of directors was established and the program became known as the Child Development Center. An after-school program was started for older children up to 12 years of age.

In 1995, the Child Development Center became a fully-owned ministry of the church under the direct supervision of the Christian education director and was officially named the Child Development Ministry (CDM). In 1997, the CDM moved to the newly purchased North Campus where the program was given more space to grow.

Four decades later, CDM continues to grow and to be committed to teaching children about God's love for them through a program of Christian education.
