

WESLEY CHANCEL CHOIR

Since the founding of First Church, the Wesley Chancel Choir has been the main choir singing each Sunday morning and at special events. The choir meets weekly to rehearse anthems and special music for worship services. Choir members are also volunteers, giving their time to assist in leading worship. YOUTH CHOIR

As part of our Music and Youth Ministry, our youth have the opportunity to participate in Youth Choir directed by Paul Inman. Members of the choir sing contemporary anthems in both Traditional and Anew worship services. This ministry provides for our 6th-12th grade students to lead in worship, singing music that is relevant in their lives.
