

## FUMC Centennial Moments for September: Music Ministry

The Handbell choirs have been a vital part of First Church since the 1980s with Joe Hester directing and Rev. Thomas Brittain, Pastor. Starting with a 3-octave set of handbells at that time, this set remains in use today by the children's choirs. In the late 1990s, after the children's choir rehearsals were moved to the North Campus, a 5-octave set of Schulmerich Bells and 5-octave set of Handchimes were added for use by adults and children for musical worship opportunities in the sanctuary. As late as 2018, a generous donation was given for a 6-octave set of Handchimes which include the large bass chimes that stand upright behind the choir.

Over the years, the Children's Handchimes and Handbells have performed at various worship events in the church. The Adult Handbell Choir plays regularly for worship services. We have also traveled to share our musical contributions with various churches in South Carolina and North Carolina. For many years, the Adult Handbell choir performed at Brookgreen Gardens and theaters in the area. Currently, we are sharing our talents with several retirement homes in the greater Myrtle Beach area.

First Church is blessed to have volunteers who have been ringers in the choir for over 20 years as we continue to add new participants each year.
