

FUMC Centennial Moments for September: Music Ministry

In the early-mid 1990s, a Monday Night Blended Worship Service grew from an interest in offering a new type of worship experience. This service was led by several musicians at that time which included Danny Chamblee, Geneal Bates, Mike Allen on guitar, John-Paul Miller on piano, McKinley Devilbus, bass, and Norman McQueen, vocals. The Monday worship moved to Wednesday evenings in September 2013 as Worship on Wednesday (WOW) with John-Paul Miller on piano and Micha Miller, song leader. Subsequently, in December 2014, the Anew Contemporary Worship was created as a Sunday service offering an expanded alternative worship experience to reach those desiring to worship in a casual, relaxed atmosphere with trending Christian music. The Anew Praise Band was formed and is currently led by Grant Nesmith on vocals and guitar, Nell Ciaccio, vocals, Chuck Powers on drums, Craig Ciaccio, percussion, Corey Merchant, bass, and Randy Wallace on piano. These dedicated volunteer musicians meet weekly to learn music and rehearse for leading worship every Sunday.
