Good Friday–Tenebrae April 15th, 6PM, Sanctuary

The Way (Stations) of the Cross has been a way to participate in the passion or suffering of Christ. Each reading is a reminder of Christ's passion journey, encouraging reflection and contemplation.





"And when they had come to the place called Calvary [the Place of a Skull] there they crucified him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left." (Luke 23:33).

At the cross, man was reconciled to God: "For if, when we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!" (Romans 5:10).

The crosses on the church's front lawn, as well as those outside the Wesley Building, remind us that Jesus died on the cross for our salvation. During Lent, the center cross has been draped in purple signifying a time of self-reflection. On Good Friday, a black drape is placed to signify that Christ died our death. Easter morning, the drape will be changed to white as a symbol of the celebration of Jesus' resurrection.

As you enter church for worship on Easter, please feel free to bring fresh-cut flowers to place on the cross in remembrance of Jesus' death and resurrection so the community and the world may know that JESUS LIVES!
