- * FUMCMB has a Missions Committee. To join this committee, contact Penny Hale, at jpkkhale@live.com or 864-423-6706.
- * The purpose of the Missions Committee is to support, serve and build relationships with local, regional, national and global outreach organizations.
- * The Missions Committee Mission Statement: Supporting Christ-focused outreach positively impacting local, regional, national and global communities while spreading God's Word of Love and Hope, and to make Disciples for Christ.
- * Missions Budget is separate to support Missions directly rather than adding to the overall budget allowing the congregation an opportunity to feel more personally involved with missions thus resulting in greater financial support of Missions.
- What is the purpose of Missions Impact Weekend? The purpose is to expose our congregation to local, regional and global missions representatives all in one place so they can ask questions and learn more about how those organizations exist, their current and future goals and needs, whether it be financial, tangible goods or volunteer/other services.
- What is a Missions Faith Promise? A Faith Promise is different from a pledge/tithe because missions is held separate from the church budget. During Missions Impact Weekend, members are asked to pray about the amount they are called to give above and beyond their tithe, as they are able. It is an individual decision in the hope that, as God provides an extra financial blessings to a person, the person will send an extra financial gift to help support Missions outreach (similar to "pay it forward").
