MISSION MOMENT—NEW DIRECTIONS

FUMC has been a huge supporter of **New Directions' mission serving homeless men, women, families with children and veterans since 2013** (now starting its 10th fiscal year). In addition to sheltering the homeless, New Directions provides an evening meal at our men's shelter to anyone in the community who is hungry 7 nights each week, 364 nights each year. New Directions also operates a Walk-In Center to accommodate the needs of the street homeless—a chance to rest, regroup and get out of the elements, a hot shower, laundry services, and case management.

New Directions is working on plans to build a new, larger women's shelter and a day center on our new lot adjacent to the men's shelter.
