

"The support from First Church continues to help Cass carry out our mission with poor people in the **Detroit** community. Some **540 homeless** men, women and children stayed in a Cass shelter this year, and 700,000 meals were prepared and served to individuals experiencing hunger. Our free medical clinic added booster shots and vaccines for Covid and the flu. Our jobs program started a new class training unemployed adults for green jobs. By Christmas, we will have 25 Tiny Homes built and occupied. The area agency on aging recently awarded funds to begin a home repair program for low-income seniors needing work done—roof repairs, furnaces replaced, ramps built, etc." [Rev.
