Proverbs 15:30: Light in a messenger's eyes brings joy to the heart, and good new gives health to the bones.

Referencing the book, Real Solutions for Caring for Your Elderly Parent, an aging parent may need help understanding common health problems that can be challenging. The caregiver plays an essential role in the sensitive nature of medical concerns. As parents age, it is important that they maintain regular contact with their physicians to monitor the aging process, particularly in the following physical systems: Skeletal, digestive, cardiovascular, and neurological. Overall physical health, proper nutrition and exercise are essential requirements for aging bodies. The caregiver should ensure that a parent schedules regular doctor visits because problems may arise, even if minor—small problems can become big ones.
