### "Peace and Understanding"

**Philipians 4:5-7:** Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Continuing in the book, **Real Solutions for Caring for Your Elderly Parent**, the authors discuss life events that lead to grief, often resulting in depression—personal, physical, and social losses, the absence of hope and purpose. Many factors play a role in the caregiver's response to support these needs—listening, asking questions, sharing, encouraging, being present and proactive—in order to understand and to be willing to provide reassurance and solutions. Spending time to make a phone call, providing a gentle touch or a hug are good ways to initiate a conversation.
