


# onthly Mission in Motion—JANUARY

Gary Rivas (*R-eye-vas*) was born in Johannesburg, South Africa. He felt his calling into the ministry as a youth and was involved in youth and young adult ministries in his church. Gary is married to Jacqui and they have two grown children. Gary was stationed in the Germiston Mission Circuit and then in East London. Jacqui was ordained into the ministry in 2003.



Gary and Jacqui served to the Fourways Circuit, and they planted Gracepoint Church together. Gary has served as superintendent of the Fourways Circuit then later elected Bishop of the Central District.
