## WORSHIP SCHEDULE—2 services only—TRADITIONAL/BLENDED

**8:30AM and 11:00AM** in the Sanctuary, **FRONT DOOR ONLY** AND Facebook Live at 8:30AM.

- Sanitization (commercial) of the Sanctuary will be done weekly and manually between services
- Please wear a **mask** during worship (one will be provided if needed)
- Keep social distance at 6 feet (2 arms' length)
- Refrain from personal contact
- Enter and leave only through the **Front Door** center aisle (if raining, enter at the breezeway side door, "Sacristy")
- Ushers will seat guests to maintain distancing (please <u>do not insist</u> on your regular seat); pews are taped for distancing guidance
- Families may sit together in one pew without distancing
- Offering plates will be situated at the doors upon exit
- As you leave, please continue to move outside for conversation
- Narthex restrooms only will be available (use nearest aisle for easy access)
- Children under 12 must be accompanied to the restroom by a parent


