CAPACITY LIMITATIONS

<u>Sanctuary</u> seating limited to <u>100 people per service</u> Contemporary seating limited to 50 people per service

***NOTE:** Call Cynthia in the church office (843-448-7164) to reserve your one service time commitment. All service reservations will remain unchanged through this temporary period. Any missed services cannot be honored at other times.

PARAMETERS

- Anyone age **65+ and others with underlying health conditions**, please remain at home and continue to view worship via Facebook, Website, or Fox TV.
- Everyone in attendance <u>must</u> wear a Face Mask while inside the church building; please bring your own mask.
- Every other pew will be roped off for distancing purposes. Families <u>may</u> sit together; however, unrelated individuals <u>must</u> observe 6-foot distance in each pew (pews will be marked for assistance). ANEW chair seating will be observed in the same manner.
- Entrance into either building will open 10 minutes prior to any service.
- Dismissal at the end of each service will be directed by Ushers to aid in timely exit followed by cleaning and disinfecting afterward. Everyone must leave the premises immediately in an orderly manner and hold conversation/visiting to the outdoors to avoid a backup at the buildings' entrances.


