MEMBER SPOTLIGHT!

CONGRATULATIONS to First Church's own Jayne Cannon who will be inducted into the Myrtle Beach High School Athletics Hall of Fame on October 2, 2020. Jayne was an MBHS Seahawk from 1953-57 and played Varsity Basketball all 4 years holding many school and state records. Jayne graduated from Coker College in 1961 where she played every sport possible. After graduation, she moved to Georgia for one year to teach in the DeKalb County Schools. Upon returning to Myrtle Beach, Jayne coached MBHS ladies basketball for 19 years. Jayne also played Short Stop for the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes, a local



softball team, earning the State Championship title that year. Jayne is a dedicated, long-time FUMC member where she taught the 3&4 year-olds Sunday School for 50 years. She participated in UMVIM working on projects in Mississippi, Houston, and Brazil; also to Asbury Hills to help prepare for summer campers. Jayne's parents, Maggie and Robert Cannon, were charter members of FUMC; the church's cornerstone bears Robert's name.
